DAY 4 - DEAUVILLE - EXCURSION TO NORMANDY LANDING BEACHES - DINARD

This morning, we depart for a powerful full day exploring the historic D-Day landing sites of Normandy, with a group lunch near Omaha Beach (wine not included). Begin in Sainte-Mère-Église at the fascinating Airborne Museum, beside the church where paratrooper John Steele famously became caught on the steeple. We then continue to Utah Beach, Pointe du Hoc, Omaha Beach, and Gold Beach, tracing the dramatic events of June 6, 1944. We conclude the day at the moving Normandy American Cemetery, overlooking the sea in solemn tribute. This evening, we continue to Dinard along the Emerald Coast for a special dinner celebrating the flavors of Brittany – we invite you to dress in stunning jewel tones for a festive and memorable night.

DAY 6 - DINARD - LOIRE VALLEY AREA - TOURS

airfare

Your departure home from Paris is on November 3, 2026, at a convenient time for your flight itinerary.

land cancellation policy

This tour is non-refundable. Trip cancellation and travel insurance are recommended and will be quoted at the time of booking. If we have a wait list, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a land-only cancellation. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot. In that case, full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are non-refundable from the time of ticketing, and no name changes are allowed on air tickets.
