We'll arrive in Ljubljana for dinner at a local restaurant.



DAY II — DUBROVNIK — EXCURSION TO KONAVLE VALLEY

Today, a city sightseeing tour will help us see exactly why Dubrovnik is known as the "Pearl of the Adriatic." The Old Town, surrounded by its remarkable city walls, is protected by UNESCO, and over the centuries, the breathtaking city has been an inspiration to many artists. "Game of Thrones" fans may recognize the formidable setting—as well as the Rector's Palace—as film locations for the epic television series. We'll take a walking tour of the area and the Rector's Palace with a local guide, then set off to discover the bounty and beauty of Konavle, known as the Golden Valley of Dubrovnik, on an exciting excursion to the southernmost point of Croatia. We'll travel through the Župa Dubrovačka valley, taking in its tiny villages and stunning assembly of vineyards, olive groves, and vegetable fields. Foodies and wine connoisseurs alike flock here, and you'll visit a local winery before heading to Močići to celebrate your journey with a farewell dinner of homemade specialties, including a tasting of locally produced liqueurs at a historic agritourism site.

Your first event will be a late afternoon walking tour of Venice on June 8, so we recommend you land by 12 p.m. Your departure home from Dubrovnik, Croatia, is on June 19, 2026, at a convenient time for your flight itinerary.

land cancellation policy

This tour is non-refundable. Trip cancellation and travel insurance are recommended and will be quoted at the time of booking. If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot, in which case full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are non-refundable from the time of ticketing. No name changes are allowed on air tickets.
