MARSEILLE – EXCURSION TO CASSIS

Explore old town Marseille on a walking tour, with time to browse before visiting Basilique Notre-Dame de la Garde for a self-guided tour. The basilica is the city’s most well-known symbol and the site of a popular Assumption pilgrimage. Depart Marseille and travel to the charming Provençal fishing village of Cassis in the heart of Calanques National Park. Explore the shops and cafes, and admire the harbor with views of the French Riviera. Return to Marseille and enjoy a group dinner this evening.

MARSEILLE – ARLES – BAUX-DE-PROVENCE – AVIGNON

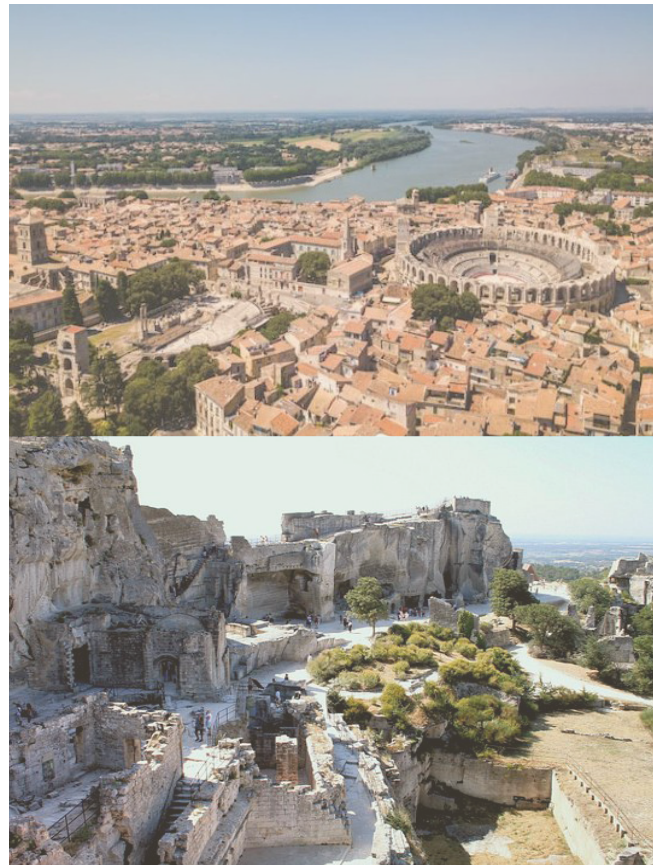

AVIGNON

Take a walking tour of Avignon with your Tour Director. From 1309 to 1377, Avignon was the seat of Catholic popes. We'll glimpse the history and culture of the Popes' Palace with a local guide. But its university students — tens of thousands of them — keep this southern French city young, exciting, and cosmopolitan. This evening, enjoy a group dinner at a popular local restaurant. Be sure to wear a lavender accessory to celebrate this beautiful region.

To arrive in Marseille on April 24 means you will depart the U.S. on April 23, 2024. Your return flight should depart from Nice Airport on May 3, 2024.

land cancellation policy

If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee.
