

ARRIVE IN ROME, ITALY



ROME – POMPEII – SORRENTO

You'll see the preserved site of excavated ruins that reveal remarkable frescoes, artwork, and artifacts that belonged to the people who perished here. Our local guide will walk us past patrician homes, public baths, and the commercial district that strikingly recalls day-to-day life when Rome was at the apex of its power. Arrive at your Sorrento hotel to freshen up and recharge before a group dinner with a cheese-pulling demo at an agriturismo, where we'll experience the seasonal aromas and flavors of regional specialties, along with local wines.



SORRENTO – EXCURSION TO POSITANO & AMALFI

Today, travel to beautiful Positano and Amalfi along the most spectacular road in Europe. 

SORRENTO - EXCURSION TO CAPRI




SORRENTO – EXCURSION TO AVELLINO

airfare

Airfare is not included, but we are happy to assist you in securing your air tickets. Our air ticketing fee is \$35 per ticket. Arrive at Rome-Fiumicino International Airport on August 15, 2023. You do not have an activity until dinner, so we recommend you arrive no later than 2 p.m. This means you will depart the U.S. on August 14, 2023. At the end of the tour, depart Rome-Fiumicino International Airport on August 23, 2023.

land cancellation policy

This tour is non-refundable. Trip cancellation and travel insurance are recommended and will be quoted at the time of booking. If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot, in which case full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are non-refundable from the time of ticketing. No name changes are allowed on air tickets.
