


VENICE – KARST REGION, SLOVENIA – POSTOJNA CAVES – LJUBLJANA

We'll visit a local winery for a wine and prosciutto tasting, then take a scenic drive into Slovenia to visit Postojna Cave Park, an incredible masterpiece of nature with magnificent halls and stalactites. We'll explore this captivating cave with a local guide as we enter the surreal subterranean world of shiny white stalagmites shaped by millions of years and millions of drops of water. We'll even see the baby dragons (olms, a type of salamander) who call these mysterious underground caverns of Slovenia home. Dinner will be in Ljubljana at a local restaurant.




PLITVICE LAKES NATIONAL PARK - ZADAR

ZADAR - SPLIT




SPLIT - EXCURSION TO HVAR




SPLIT - STON - DUBROVNIK

Travel to Ston to visit a local shellfish farm during a boat tour that includes a welcome drink and traditional homemade sweets of sugared orange peel and sugared almonds. We'll continue to Dubrovnik for a group dinner at a local restaurant.

DUBROVNIK - EXCURSION TO KONAVLE VALLEY

Take a city sightseeing tour to learn why Dubrovnik is known as the "Pearl of the Adriatic." The old town is surrounded by remarkable city walls and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Over the centuries, this breathtaking city has been an inspiration to many artists. "Game of Thrones" fans may recognize this formidable setting and the Rector's Palace as film locations for the epic television series. After a walking tour with a local guide that includes the Rector's Palace, we'll then set off to discover the bounty and beauty of Konavle, the "Golden Valley of Dubrovnik," on an exciting excursion to the southernmost point of Croatia. As we travel through the Župa Dubrovačka valley, we'll see its tiny villages and stunning assembly of vineyards, olive groves, and vegetable fields. Foodies and wine connoisseurs alike flock here, and you'll visit a local winery before heading to Močići to celebrate with a Farewell Dinner of homemade specialties, including a tasting of locally produced liqueurs at a historic agritourism business/site.

airfare

An arrival transfer will be included. Your first event will be a late afternoon walking tour of Venice on May 16, so we recommend you land by 12 p.m. Your departure home from Dubrovnik is on May 27, 2024, at a convenient time for your flight itinerary.

land cancellation policy

This tour is non-refundable. Trip cancellation and travel insurance are recommended and will be quoted at the time of booking. If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot, in which case full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are non-refundable from the time of ticketing. No name changes are allowed on air tickets.
