Today is a full day of touring, with a morning departure and lunch on your own in Omaha Beach, Normandy. We'll start the tour in Sainte-Mère-Église to see the Airborne Museum (located next to the bell tower where American paratrooper John Steele's parachute got caught). Then, we'll visit Utah Beach, Pointe du Hoc, Omaha Beach, and Arromanches-les-Bains (Gold Beach) before ending the day at the Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial in Colleville-sur-Mer. We'll overnight in Saint-Malo, with dinner at a local restaurant.

SAINT-MALO — MONT-SAINT-MICHEL

In the morning, visit the famous Abbey of Mont-Saint-Michel, which is spectacularly perched on a rocky isle in the Gulf of Saint-Malo. You'll have free time to explore the area on your own before we visit Hôtel de l'Abbaye for a tasting of some of its quality wines. We'll return to Saint-Malo for an evening at your leisure.

SAINT-MALO – LOIRE VALLEY AREA – BLOIS

Travel to the Loire Valley to visit a goat farm, learn about its cheese production, and enjoy a cheese tasting of local chèvre, a specialty of the region. Next, we'll tour the lovely Château de Chenonceau, where Catherine de Medici lived in the 16th century, with an audio guide. We'll continue to Blois for your two-night stay.

BLOIS – CHATEAU COUNTRY

After breakfast, visit the market in Blois with free time to browse and shop. Then, we'll travel to the jewel of the French Renaissance: Château de Chambord. After some free time for lunch, we'll continue to Les Caves du Père Auguste to visit its troglodyte wine cellars and enjoy a presentation of its winemaking processes. Our tour of the cellars will include a wine tasting of five Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée (AOC) wines accompanied by local charcuterie and chèvre. Afterward, we'll enjoy a guided tour of Château de Nitray, where we'll visit the wine warehouses that have operated for 250 years and learn about the wine-making process. Then, we'll take part in the Initiation to Oenology Course with a wine pairing, followed by dinner.

BLOIS - VERSAILLES - PARIS

After breakfast, depart for the town of Versailles — built during Louis XIII's reign — to visit the second-largest market in France and the oldest market in Versailles. You'll have some free time to explore the market before we visit the lavish, 17th-century baroque Palace of Versailles, built by the Sun King, Louis XIV, with its magnificent State Apartments, Hall of Mirrors, and Royal Chapel. Your guide will bring the palace's history to life during your visit, and you'll have time at leisure to stroll through parts of the elegant 250-acre gardens. Louis XIII originally purchased Versailles and its surrounding land to serve as his hunting lodge. Later, his son, Louis XIV, decided to make it his seat of government, and in 1682, he installed his impressive court and numerous noble visitors in sumptuous surroundings, a symbol of absolute monarchy. Tonight in Paris, we'll enjoy dinner at a popular local restaurant.

We'll drive by the Seine River and its beautiful bridges, where you can stop to take photos of the iconic Eiffel Tower from one of the best panoramic viewing points. Tonight, we'll celebrate the success of your tour with a Farewell Dinner at a popular local restaurant.
