LISBON - EXCURSION TO BELÉM - COLARES - CASCAIS

This morning, visit Belém, an important historic district from Portugal's Golden Age. Belém is a laid-back area on the Tagus River known for its seafood restaurants and houses decorated with colorful tiles. Take a tuk-tuk sightseeing tour of Belém, then travel to Colares for lunch at a winery. Afterward, explore the seaside resort of Cascais, a formerly sleepy fishing village that attracted King Luís I in the 1870s and became the Portuguese royal family's summer residence. Today, it is an elegant town filled with winding pedestrian lanes and shops. Enjoy free time before dinner with a view. Return to Lisbon.

LISBON - CASA CADAVAL - BAIÃO




BAIÃO - EXCURSION TO DOURO VALLEY

Explore the Douro Valley with a day trip through the mountainous and rugged wine regions cut by the Douro River. You'll also see human-made contours of narrow stonewalled vine terraces in this region that has been named a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Douro Valley is famed for being the oldest demarcated wine-growing region on the planet (meaning it's defined by strict boundaries). Enjoy a lunch of regional cuisine before a visit to two wineries to taste and tour before returning to your hotel for an evening at your leisure.

BAIÃO - PENAFIEL - PORTO





airfare

Airfare is not included, but we are happy to assist you in securing your air tickets. Our air ticketing fee is \$35 per ticket. You need to arrive in Lisbon, Portugal, on September 7, 2023, which means you need to depart the U.S. on September 6, 2023. An arrival transfer will be included. Your first event will be a late-afternoon Lisbon City Tour on September 7, so we recommend you land by 12 p.m. Your departure home from Porto is September 15, 2023, at a convenient time for your flight itinerary.

land cancellation policy

This tour is nonrefundable. Trip cancellation and travel insurance is recommended and will be quoted at the time of booking. If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot, in which case full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are nonrefundable from the time of ticketing. No name changes are allowed on air tickets.
