Keep your camera ready, as we may also spot impalas, giraffes, hippos, spotted hyenas, cheetahs, wildebeest, and more. Our journey will lead us to Zimbabwe and one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World: the stunning Victoria Falls, known as "the smoke that thunders." We'll hike along the falls, enjoy a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River, and visit an elephant orphanage. From sophisticated cities, stunning panoramas, and enthralling vineyards to exciting game drives and thundering waters, Southern Africa offers a natural beauty and rich history you wor't want to miss.




CAPE TOWN – STELLENBOSCH







VICTORIA FALLS

No photograph can begin to depict the reality, and nothing can prepare you for your first sight. Journey through the rainforest with an expert guide, and learn the history of the falls and the flora and fauna. Next up is the Elephant Encounter, which will afford guests the opportunity to unobtrusively observe some of the biggest personalities in Africa, in a pristine wilderness environment overflowing with raw natural beauty. An open-design thatch boma (small shelter) gives a view of the beautiful Masuwe River, and against this breathtaking backdrop, guests will be given an insightful presentation about Wild Horizons Elephant Sanctuary and Orphanage. Venture out into the bush to spend time with the elephants and witness the special relationship the elephant keepers share with the animals. You will have the opportunity to photograph the elephants, marvel at their size, and watch them behave normally and interact with one another. Your departure home from Johannesburg is on October 31, 2023. Flights should be scheduled after 6 p.m.
