FLORENCE – CHIANTI – SIENA

This is an extraordinary day devoted to Tuscan wines and great foods. We'll begin by traveling to Chianti area, which offers a unique landscape of green, gentle hills covered with wide fields of vineyards and olive groves; small stone villages; Romanesque parishes, and countryside homes made from stone. The Chianti landscapes are so beautiful that they inspire many photographs, postcards, and calendars that are distributed across the globe. Any wine produced in the Chianti region of central Tuscany, is considered Chianti, and historically it was associated with a squat bottle enclosed in a straw basket called a "fiasco". However, the fiasco is now only used by a few winemakers, most Chianti, today is bottled in a more standard-shape wine bottle. We will visit a fabulous winery today to enjoy a tour, tastings, and Tuscan cuisine. Then we'll overnight in Siena, located in the heart of Tuscany and known for its well-preserved medieval architecture, rich history, cultural heritage, and beautiful countryside.

airfare

Your departure home from Florence is on June 10, 2024, at a convenient time for your flight itinerary.

land cancellation policy

If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee.
