
BARCELONA - SARAGOSSA (ZARAGOZA)

Today, enjoy a guided sightseeing tour that includes Palau de la Música Catalana and panoramic views of the city and harbor from Montjuïc Hill. We'll also stop at Sagrada Familia Basilica, Columbus Monument, Plaza de Cataluña, and Paseo de Gracia. The Basilica of Sagrada Familia stands in Barcelona as a monument to the Holy Family and a testament to the masterwork of architect and designer Antoni Gaudí. Built on the reliance of donations since the first stone was laid more than 140 years ago, the iconic church remains an unfinished masterpiece and the world's longest-running construction project – slated for completion in 2026 on the 100th anniversary of the architect's death. We'll continue to Saragossa for a two-night stay, with dinner included this evening.

BILBAO - SAN SEBSTIÁN

Take a guided visit to Guggenheim Bilbao Museum. Founded in 1997, the museum was designed by world-renowned architect Frank Gehry and has been hailed as one of the most important buildings of its time because of its spectacular structure of titanium, glass, and limestone. The museum features extraordinary exhibitions administered by the Guggenheim Foundation, as well as selections from the permanent collections of the Guggenheim museums in New York; Venice, Italy; and Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates. We'll continue on to San Sebastián for your three-night stay, then enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

SAN SEBSTIÁN — EXCURSION TO FRANCE

Enjoy the morning at your leisure in beautiful San Sebastián. This afternoon, we'll travel north into France to explore two dazzling seaside resorts along the Côte Basque. We'll begin in glamorous Biarritz, where European royalty and the world's rich and famous have summered for centuries. Your expert guide will give you a proper introduction to this "Beach of Kings" during a walking tour featuring the elegant Belle Époque architecture, iconic Rocher de la Vierge (Rock of the Virgin), bustling Old Port, and grand Hôtel du Palais, the summer villa of Napoleon III's wife, Eugénie. Upon our return south, we'll stop in Saint-Jean-de-Luz, which has a rare, sheltered bay and sandy beaches that make it a popular vacation destination. Led by your expert guide, you'll see the highlights — including the church where the royal wedding between Louis XIV and Marie-Thérèse of Spain took place in 1660 — and hear how the town owes much of its historic wealth to the piracy activities of Basque corsairs in the 17th century. Return to San Sebastián for dinner.
