JULY 18 - 28, 2026

Indulge your curiosities and inner explorer on this journey to South Africa. Join Cooper's Hawk hosts Tom Koenigsberg, Chief Strategy Officer, and his wife, Kris Koenigsberg, Cooper's Hawk Brand Ambassador, on this tour where you will encounter different cultures and learn new things for the simple joy of learning. We'll revive our senses with outstanding South African wines and delicious local cuisine. The aromas drifting from grills in outdoor market areas and the brilliant color of their wares are incredible. We start with the sights in the cosmopolitan city of Cape Town, one of the most beautiful cities in the world. We'll explore the Cape Peninsula all the way down to the Cape of Good Hope, then spend time in the Stellenbosch and Franschhoek winelands. Unique winery visits and a curated wine encounter on the Wine Tram, along with interactive experiences, give us the opportunity to learn about local grape varieties and aspects of viticulture distinctive to Southern Africa. We continue to Kapama Private Game Reserve, where we'll venture out on game drives in an open-air, four-wheel-drive Land Cruiser. Our professional ranger and skilled tracker will help us search for a remarkable number of species, including the Big Five—lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and Cape buffalo. Keep your camera ready, as we may also spot impala, giraffe, hippo, spotted hyena, cheetah, wildebeest and more. Our journey leads us to Zimbabwe and the stunning Victoria Falls, known as the "smoke that thunders" and one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. We'll hike along the falls, enjoy a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River, and visit an elephant orphanage. From sophisticated cities, stunning panoramas, enthralling vineyards, exciting game drives and thundering waters—you won't want to miss the natural beauty and rich history of this fascinating land.

DAY 2 — CAPE TOWN

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before your Table Mountain and city tour. The highlight of this day includes a visit to the summit of Table Mountain, South Africa's prominent landmark, via aerial cableway (weather permitting). Other stops include the Malay Quarter, city center, Company's Garden, the Castle of Good Hope and Diamond Works. Discover the history of the diamond and gold trade in South Africa and witness the art of diamond cutting and the craftsmanship of jewelry manufacturing by skilled experts during a sparkling tour. Enjoy chocolate-and-wine pairing during your tour. We'll have a light lunch at the waterfront before your helicopter sightseeing flight on the Atlantico. This 16-minute flight is an idyllic treat as you soar over Cape Town's scenic City Bowl and out over the Atlantic Ocean. We will return to our hotel for leisure time. Enjoy a three-course wine-pairing welcome dinner in The Greenhouse at the hotel, where the chef and the sommelier will stop by to meet our group.

DAY 3 — CAPE TOWN

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then visit the Cape Point Nature Reserve and the tip of the Cape Peninsula that has captivated travelers for centuries. We'll head to Cape Point with a stop in Simon's Town to enjoy lunch at Black Marlin restaurant. From here we continue to Boulders Beach before making our way back to the hotel in the afternoon.

With a global reputation for excellence, Delaire Graff Estate is an essential South African destination. Then head to Stellenbosch for a visit to Boschendal. Enjoy a picnic lunch and tasting at Boschendal before continuing to our hotel. After check-in, enjoy a tasting at the Lanzerac estate.

DAY 5 — STELLENBOSCH

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before transferring to the Wine Tram station for a curated wine experience. Journey by tram to a local estate where a knowledgeable wine expert weaves the facts, figures and scientific aspects of winemaking into stories about Franschhoek's history of wine and culture. During this interactive experience, you will sample the subtle tastes of terroir and learn about local grape varieties, cultivars and aspects of viticulture unique to Southern Africa. A tour of the estate wine cellar will be followed by a specially curated three-course lunch at the estate restaurant. After lunch, you will visit two additional top Franschhoek estates, enjoying a premium tasting at each. Prepare to leave this experience feeling more knowledgeable and connected to the local wine culture, and ready to discover the Franschhoek Valley further.






DAY 6 — STELLENBOSCH — CAPE TOWN — KAPAMA GAME RESERVE

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before transferring to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Hoedspruit. On arrival, you will be met and transferred to Kapama River Lodge. The largest of the Kapama Private Game Reserve camps, River Lodge's wide, open spaces and airy design are a constant reminder that you are sleeping under the African sky. This afternoon, encounter a diverse range of animal and bird species on your game drive on the Big Five reserve. Dinner will be enjoyed at the lodge.

DAY 7 — KAPAMA GAME RESERVE

Depart for an early morning game drive on the reserve. On your drives you can expect to encounter a diverse range of animal and bird species. Since this is a Big Five reserve, encountering lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo is possible over a two-day safari. While seeing big game is always exhilarating, many smaller species are also captivating, and birding enthusiasts will be delighted by the approximately 350 species recorded on the reserve. Throughout the day, it's likely you will see wildlife such as nyala antelope, vervet monkeys or even some of the Big Five. Return to the lodge for breakfast, leisure time and lunch. Enjoy an afternoon game drive before a group dinner at the lodge.

DAY 8 — KAPAMA GAME RESERVE

Another exciting day is ahead with two game drives, one in the early morning and the other in the afternoon. You'll again encounter a diverse range of animal and bird species and search for the Big Five. Breakfast will be after the morning drive, followed by leisure time and lunch. Enjoy a group dinner in a private Boma wing at the lodge. To capture the setting sun in our extraordinary surroundings, please wear attire in the colors of an African sunset.

DAY 9 — KAPAMA GAME RESERVE — VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

Enjoy an early breakfast at the lodge before your road transfer to Kruger Mpumalanga Airport for your flight to Victoria Falls. Upon arrival, guests will experience the Elephant Encounter. The encounter affords guests the opportunity to unobtrusively observe some of the biggest personalities in Africa in a pristine wilderness environment overflowing with raw natural beauty. An open-design thatch boma gives a view of the Masuwe River, and against this backdrop, guests will be given an insightful presentation on the Wild Horizons Elephant Sanctuary and Orphanage. Venture into the bush to spend time with the elephants and witness the special relationship the keepers share with the animals. You will have the opportunity to take photographs, marvel at their size and watch them browsing and interacting with one another. After the encounter, enjoy a selection of refreshments in the cool of the Wild Horizons Elephant Wallow.

DAY 10 — VICTORIA FALLS

DAY II — VICTORIA FALLS — JOHANNESBURG O.R. TAMBO AIRPORT

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for your flight to Johannesburg's O.R. Tambo International Airport and your flight home (do not schedule before 6 p.m.).

The airlines will deny boarding if you do not have this. This tour requires a minimum of 20 people to operate. Wineries, hotels, dinners, activities, game drives and attractions are subject to change. Please read the attached booking terms and conditions for further details and important information. Inoculations may be required for travel to South Africa. Please consult your physician and the CDC for regulations and recommendations.

airfare

Airfare is not included, but we are happy to assist you in securing your tickets. Our air-ticketing fee is \$60 per ticket. You need to arrive in Cape Town on July 18, 2026, which means you need to depart the U.S. on July 17, 2026. An arrival transfer will be included. As most flights arrive late afternoon or evening, there will be no group events on July 18 to allow time to settle in and rest from the long journey. Your departure home from Johannesburg is on July 28, 2026; flights should be scheduled after 6 p.m.

land cancellation policy

This tour is nonrefundable. Because the tour is nonrefundable regardless of your reason for cancellation, we recommend trip-cancellation and travel insurance and will provide you with a quote. A minimum level of during-travel insurance coverage, including Travel Medical Expense and Emergency Evacuation, is mandatory for this tour. FROSCH by Chase Travel can assist with both pre- and during-travel insurance options. If you choose to obtain coverage on your own, you must supply the insurance company name and policy number to us.

If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a land cancellation. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot, in which case full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are nonrefundable from the time of ticketing. No name changes are allowed on air tickets.
