Day 1 – 13 OCT (THU) – ARRIVE IN ROME - SORRENTO, ITALY

Highlights – Tasting Lemon Jams & Limoncello; Farm Visit to taste Mozzarella; Winery Visit

This is followed with a visit to a farm in the Salerno province of Paestrum to savor homemade mozzarella di bufala. AIRFARE

Airfare is not included but we are happy to assist you secure your air tickets. Arrive at Rome Fiumicino Airport on October 13, 2022, by 9:15 a.m. to catch the group transfer. This means you will depart the USA on October 12, 2022. The group transfer will align for flights departing from Rome Fiumicino Airport on October 20, 2022, at 9:45 a.m. or later. If you cannot meet up with the group transfer a separate transfer can be provided for you at an additional cost. If you do not take the group arrival transfer, you will miss the tour that afternoon that occurs on the way from the airport to the hotel. There is no refund if you do not take this transfer/tour.

LAND CANCELLATION POLICY-PER PERSON

This tour is non-refundable. Trip cancellation and travel insurance is recommended and will be quoted at the time of booking. If we have a waitlist, we may be able to assist with a name change instead of a cancellation on land only. Name changes have a \$200 per person administrative fee. There is no guarantee we will have someone to take your spot in which case full cancellation fees will apply. Air tickets are non-refundable from the time of ticketing. No name changes are allowed on air tickets.
